POLICY STATEMENT

It is the intention of Howard Construction (Anglia) Ltd to establish and maintain procedures to specify its environmental objectives.

Howard Construction (Anglia) Ltd is committed not only to meet all relevant regulatory and legislative requirements but also seek to secure continual improvement in environmental performance.

In pursuance of this policy, Howard Construction (Anglia) Ltd (HCA) will endeavor to:-

- a) Minimize any disturbances to the local and global environment and to the quality of life of the local communities in which the company operates; generally, for the company to be a good neighbor and responsible member of society.
- b) Comply fully with all statutory regulations controlling the company and the sites on which it operates.
- c) Maintain the appearance of the company premises to the highest practical standards.
- d) Take positive steps to conserve resources, particularly those which are scarce or nonrenewable.
- e) Assess, in advance where possible, the environmental effects of any significant new development and adjust the company's plans accordingly.

f) Provide the information necessary to enable the company's products to be properly used, stored and disposed of so as to avoid unacceptable effects on man or the environment.

g) Provide the necessary information to enable employees to operate the processes properly and with minimal effects on man or the environment.

h) Keep the public informed of major new projects in their locality.

l) Nuisance – a degree of nuisance, particularly noise, is an inevitable consequence of the company's activities, it must be ensured that nuisance caused by operations is kept to a minimum and any complaints received will be dealt with promptly and sympathetically within the operational constraints that apply.


J) Customers and suppliers will be encouraged to support these objectives by minimising environmental impact through waste.
